THE ANNUNCIATION

And the angel said to her, "Do not be afraid, Mary, for you have found favor with God. And behold, you will conceive in your womb and bear a son, and you shall call his name Jesus. He will be great and will be called the Son of the Most High. Mary said, "Behold, I am the handmaid of the Lord; let it be to me according to your word." Luke 1:30-32, 38

I pray that Jesus will shelter Fr. _____ within His Sacred Heart and to keep his anointed hands unstained which daily touch His Sacred Body.

THE VISITATION

Mary set out and journeyed in haste into the hill country to a town of Judah where she entered the house of Zechariah and greeted Elizabeth. When Elizabeth heard Mary's greeting, the baby leaped in her womb. Then Elizabeth was filled with the Holy Spirit, and she exclaimed with a loud cry, "Blessed are you among women, and blessed is the fruit of your womb. And why am I so greatly favored that the mother of my Lord should visit me? And blessed is she who believed that what the Lord has said to her will be fulfilled." Luke 1:39-43, 45

THE FINDING OF JESUS IN THE TEMPLE

Every year Jesus' parents used to go to Jerusalem for the feast of Passover. When the days of the feast were over and they set off for home, the boy Jesus stayed behind in Jerusalem. His parents were not aware of this. Assuming he was somewhere in the group of travelers, they journeyed for a day. Then they started to look for him among their relatives and friends, but when they failed to find him, they returned to Jerusalem to search for him. After three days they found him in the temple, where he was sitting among the teachers, listening to them and asking them questions. Luke 2:41, 43-46

THE AGONY OF JESUS IN THE GARDEN

And Jesus withdrew from them about a stone's throw, and knelt down and prayed, "Father, if you are willing, remove this cup from me; nevertheless not my will, but yours, be done." And there appeared to him an angel from heaven, strengthening him. And being in an agony he prayed more earnestly; and his sweat became like great drops of blood falling down upon the ground. Luke 22:41-44

THE SCOURGING OF JESUS AT THE PILLAR

Then, having said this, Pilate went out again to the Jews and said, "I find no evidence of a crime in this man. But according to your custom, I release one prisoner to you at Passover. Do you want me to release to you the King of the Jews?" They shouted, "Not this man, but Barabbas!" Now Barabbas was a thief. Then Pilate ordered that Jesus be scourged. John 18:38-40, 19:1

THE CROWNING OF JESUS WITH THORNS

Then the governor's soldiers took Jesus inside the praetorium and stripped him and put a scarlet robe on him, and after twisting some thorns into a crown, they placed it on his head and put a reed in his right hand. Then, bending the knee before him, they mocked him, saying, "Hail, King of the Jews!" Matthew 27:28-29

JESUS CARRIES HIS HEAVY CROSS

THE CRUCIFIXION AND DEATH OF JESUS
